Hmm... I thought CF-Cards can be used and will be detected as a normal harddrive.

They can IMHO be used like a normal removable medium, e.g. like a MO medium or a ZIP disk or a CD-RAM or a SmartMedia card.

So removeable or not shouldn't make a difference.

I've already written that it makes a difference.

Try to create two partitions on an USB stick with Windows, then you see that even other OSes believe that removable media are something different than a harddrive.

As far as I know CF-Cards can also partitioning with HDToolBox or HDInstTools. So writing a RDB should be possible too.

Of course its possible to create a RIGID disk block on a REMOVABLE medium with those tools, even with Media Toolbox. This doesnt change the fact that SFS will refuse to handle such partitions. Use a MountList with LowCyl=0.
