Here are the results of some experiments I performed today.
My system is a MicroA1 with AmigaOS 4.1 with QuickFixes.
Western Digital 250 GB 3.5" hard drive
I already have two FFS partitions and a JXFS partition.
I am trying to add a second JXFS partition.

Added a 100 GB JXFS partition ... seemed ok until I did a cold boot.
