I must admit to being foolish. I added the assigns to Libs: and Fonts: and satisfied myself that Wordworth started and ran OK. I didn't think of loading an old document or testing it.

When I came to load an old document or even to type in the box, I soon discovered that nothing is displayed. The cursor moves normally, but no text appears - it's as though it were white text on a white background.

I've checked with Snoopy and everything is found OK. There are no error messages. I've run "FixFonts" and the WwFonts are within the list of fonts that are "fixed", so it knows where they are. The ENVARC:Wordworth/WwFonts file points to the WwFonts directory in the Wordworth folder.

I can highlight the invisible text in the document and the area of highlighted text looks correct. If I RAmiga/C to Copy it, I can then paste it into a Notepad document and get the right text, so it's there, I just can't see it.

This is not a clean installation, the original disks are nowhere to be found. However, this installation was last used (with OS4.0) in 2007, so it's worked OK since the OS3.9 days.

When I find out what's causing it, I'll let you know.
