Well, one thing is: does it use cmake? Because that tends to make certain things easier and certain other things disastefully incomprehensible. Other build issues might be to structure code and build processes in ways, that are in theory consistent with how Qt works, but somehow not along the the lines of what it was intended to do. In which case it will most likely not have been taken into account by the amiga port. I've seen lots of those things happen over rime. Qthreads issues tend to be the most tricky, Because AmigaOS and pthreads on os4 tend to not always do exactly what other systems might do under the same conditions. With the added bonus, that you are now dealing with asynchronous code, so you don't have any idea whatsoever of what order things are actually happening in, let alone where your error messages are actually comming from (if you even get any).
